EXTRA CREDIT PAPER

Instructions for Writing Response Papers for Credit:

1. Choose a topic or general theme discussed in this course.
2. The main purpose of the paper is to encourage the student to do one or more of the following:
 - a. Research the topic using the Bible and other sources.
 - b. Reason using biblical principles relating to the topic.
 - c. Relate these principles and newly discovered biblical truth to your own understanding and experience.
3. Paper minimum is two (2) pages, 12 pt. font, standard margins and spacing. Longer papers are welcome and encouraged. Please limit long scripture references.
4. Topic must have instructor's prior approval. Please submit the following form if you intend to write a response paper.

4. Write a comprehensive book report, two (2) page minimum, 12 pt. font, standard margins and spacing. Please limit long scripture references. The paper should contain:
 - a. The author's main message
 - b. The reader's personal benefit from reading the book.
5. Book reports must be submitted in no later than two weeks after the last scheduled class for the course.
